The Orange Door is a new way for women, children and young people who are experiencing family violence or families who need assistance with the care and wellbeing of children to access the services they need to be safe and supported.

The Orange Door also works with people who use violence to help them change their behaviour.

Contact The Orange Door if:

- Someone close to you is hurting you, controlling you or making you feel afraid, such as your partner, family member, housemate or carer
- You are struggling with parenting due to money issues, family conflict, illness, addiction, grief or isolation
- You are concerned about the wellbeing of a child or young person
- You are concerned about the safety of a friend or family member
- You are using violence and you want to change your behaviour

This is a free service

The Orange Door welcomes people of any age, gender, sexuality, culture and ability.

The Orange Door works with local Aboriginal services and communities, multicultural services, LGBTI and disability services to meet the diverse needs of individuals and families.

The Orange Door will connect you to the services you need and work with you to support you and your family to stay safe.

Behaviour change programs will not be held at The Orange Door.
